


There is never a dull moment with special events such as wine tasting, festivals, fireworks and torchlight parades throughout the year.



Home to the 1960 Winter Olympics, Squaw Valley USA has 4,000 acres of world-class terrain for skiers and snowboarders of all levels.

When it's time to relax




For pampering and rejuvenation, discover the tranquility of the Spa. Located in the heart of the Village, it's the perfect escape for corporate events, private parties or incentives.

The Village boasts many delicious restaurants and cafés—the options are endless.




Dine in the European-style pedestrian village or take the scenic aerial Cable Car to High Camp, el. 8,200' for award winning menus and breathtaking views

Whether you're entertaining, conducting business or relaxing, you'll be doing it in luxury.



All-weather highways lead directly to Squaw Valley USA. It's a three hour scenic drive from San Francisco, two hours from Sacramento and 45 minutes from Reno. Shuttle and Taxi service is available.

FROM THE RENO/TAHOE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Take 395 North to Route 80 West for 35 miles. Take exit 185 to 89 South/Lake Tahoe. Turn left off the ramp and follow 89 South for about eight miles before turning right on to Squaw Valley Road. Take this road for two miles and turn left on to Village East Road, over a small bridge. The entrance/lobby will be 300 yards ahead of you on the right in the 22 Station East Building.

FROM THE SAN FRANCISCO/SACRAMENTO AREA

Take I-80 East to Exit 185, 89 South/Lake Tahoe. Turn right off the ramp and follow 89 South for about eight miles before turning right on to Squaw Valley Road. Take this road for two miles and turn left on to Village East Road, over a small bridge. The entrance/lobby will be 300 yards ahead of you on the right in the 22 Station East Building.
