As North Lake Tahoe's spring melts into summer, the runoff from the snowfall rejuvenates and restores the green back into the courses. North Lake Tahoe is home to six championship golf courses and four executive courses which are all opening up as weather permits.

Remember, when you're planning your 2020 golf day in Tahoe, plan ahead for any new rules you may find at the golf course.

- o Bring your own clubs if possible to avoid additional risk, and if that's not possible, confirm in advance that the course you're visiting has rentals available.
- Tee times are required in advance.
- You'll be riding in your golf cart solo, or with someone who lives in your home, and it's suggested that every golfer wear a mask. And, be sure to bring along disinfectant, to wipe down the cart surfaces and golf clubs, as well as your hand sanitizer.
- Courses are encouraging "gimmies" on the green to reduce crowding near the hole.
- Check to see which courses are currently open and accepting out of town visitors.

<u>Tahoe City Golf Course</u> is the oldest course in Tahoe. Enjoy a fun family-friendly day, including your dog if you'd like, on this 9 hole course in the heart of Tahoe City.

<u>Old Brockway Golf Course</u> is a picturesque, family-owned 9 hole course. It's not too hilly, a little tight but not too tough for beginners and sits right across the street from Lake Tahoe in Kings Beach.

<u>Incline Village Mountain Course</u> features an amazing mountain layout with old growth trees, elevation changes and the stunning backdrop of the Sierra Nevada Mountains and Lake Tahoe.

<u>Incline Village Championship Course</u> features tightly cut fairways and fast greens, which demand accuracy and distance. Try not to get distracted by the beautiful lake views.
